What constitutes a reportable disruption and what is required to address the disruption shall be defined in an ETC's 911 plan. Notifications need to explain the area affected, number of customer of customers affected, and expected length of outage as required in an ETC's plan. Immediately upon Within 3 days of restoration of service, the notice shall report ETC shall provide a narrative of the outage, the duration of the outage and the root cause of the outage to the DPS, the PUC, and Commerce.
