CUB offers the following alternate decision options for consideration during Agenda Item 4 of the December 8, 2022 Commission Hearing. Specifically, we propose a new Decision Option, 2A, and modifications to existing Decision Option 11 included in the briefing papers. These decision options reflect recommendations CUB included in the comments we filed on October 14, 2022 in these dockets.

## **CUB Decision Alternatives**

**2A**. Order each Gas Utility to, within sixty days following the occurrence of the below triggering event, make a notice filing to the Commission identifying its costs for procuring gas for Minnesota customers while gas prices were inflated, what actions the utility took to account for or mitigate those costs, and justifications for why its actions were prudent.

## Notice filing triggering event

The gas day (or multiple days in the case of weekends and holidays) settled Gas Daily index price at any pricing hub where the utility purchased daily supplies to serve its Minnesota customers is greater than or equal to \$20.00 per Dth. (CUB)

**11.** Order Gas Utilities to explore the development of develop for inclusion in their next rate case new interruptible service offerings that are designed to allow for a reasonable degree of economic curtailments in future heating seasons. (DOC, CUB)
