**Comments of the Citizens Utility Board of Minnesota**

The Citizens Utility Board of Minnesota ("CUB") respectfully submits these comments in response to the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission's ("the Commission") February 7, 2022 Notice of Comment Period. Specifically, we provide comments with respect to scoping and procedures for Xcel's cost recovery request of its Advanced Grid Intelligence and Security ("AGIS")-related costs. CUB recommends that the Commission bifurcate cost recovery decisions related to AGIS and non-AGIS costs and refer Xcel's AGIS-related costs to the Office of Administrative Hearings for a contested case proceeding.

CUB especially appreciates the Guidance Document produced by Synapse Energy Economics, Inc. ("Synapse") for the Minnesota Department of Commerce ("the Department") and filed by the Department in the present docket.<sup>1</sup> We have found that Document to be very useful and generally support its conclusions and recommendations.

**I. Procedural history**

On November 1, 2019, Xcel Energy ("Xcel") presented its proposed investments in Advanced Metering Infrastructure ("AMI") and a Field Area Network ("FAN"), two core components of its AGIS initiative, in its 2019 Integrated Distribution Plan ("IDP," Docket No. 19-666) and requested certification of these and other investments.<sup>2</sup> Xcel's 2019 IDP was an extensive filing that included approximately 30 attachments, including Xcel's cost-benefit analysis of the AMI and FAN proposals and direct testimony from five witnesses.

In the comment period that followed, comments were filed by ten parties (including CUB) and presented a wide range of analyses and recommendations regarding the proposed investments, Xcel's cost-benefit analysis, the legal question of certification, the appropriateness of rider recovery, critical consumer protections, and other topics. Multiple parties (including CUB) engaged outside experts to assist with the complex analysis.

The Commission met to consider Xcel's IDP on May 29, 2020 and issued its written order on July 23, 2020. In that order, the Commission certified Xcel's AMI and FAN proposals and noted:

[C]ertification of the AMI and FAN projects in this order is made with the recognition that future cost recovery will be based upon a utility accomplishing Commission-approved metrics and performance evaluations for the certified projects. Any future proposals for cost recovery of investments certified in this order must be accompanied by a proposal for specific metrics and evaluation methods, and a detailed plan describing how the company will maximize the benefits of the investments for ratepayers.<sup>3</sup>

The order requested that the Department conduct a stakeholder process and "file a report by November 1, 2020, including recommendations on specific metrics, detailed methods for evaluating performance, and consumer protections or other conditions, including cost caps, that should be applied to the certified projects."<sup>4</sup>

Additionally, the order stated:

The Commission clarifies in this order that certification does not constitute a pre-judgment of whether costs will be recovered through riders or base rates. Certification simply permits a utility to request rider recovery in the future, which the Commission may approve or deny based on the facts available at that time.<sup>5</sup>

Further, the order required Xcel to file "preferred procedural paths forward" for cost recovery of the certified investments and established that the Commission would conduct a comment and reply process and make a "procedural and scoping decision prior to the consideration of a rider recovery determination."<sup>6</sup>

Following that order, multiple additional dockets were initiated. In Docket No. 20-627, on August 21, 2020, the Department began a "written, comment-based stakeholder process" on the metrics, performance evaluation methods, and consumer protection conditions to be applied to Xcel's AMI

and FAN projects.<sup>7</sup> Six parties (including CUB) filed comments, and the Department filed its report on December 1, 2020.<sup>8</sup>

On August 28, 2020, Xcel filed its preferred procedural paths for cost recovery of its AGIS projects.<sup>9</sup> The Commission initiated a separate docket (20-680) and requested comments in a September 23, 2020 notice. Four parties (including CUB) submitted comments, in addition to Xcel. To CUB's knowledge, this matter has not yet been taken up by the Commission.

Also in 2020, Xcel proposed multiple projects in response to a Commission request for utility projects that could assist in Minnesota's recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic, and Xcel filed a general rate case and a rate case stay-out proposal.<sup>10</sup> These dockets related to, or had the potential to interact with, Xcel's AGIS proposals and cost recovery, evidenced by the fact that party filings and Commission orders from late 2020 sometimes referenced as many as eight dockets.<sup>11</sup>

## II. Discussion

CUB agrees with the Department that the scale of the proposed investments "demand that extraordinary consideration, evaluation, and opportunity for careful and thorough review of proposed grid modernization investments be provided in order to protect the interests of utility ratepayers and promote the public interest."<sup>12</sup> Xcel's AMI and FAN projects are large and complex investments. Xcel estimates that, together, the projects will cost \$563.7 million<sup>13</sup> and have a monthly cost of \$2.87 for

the average residential customer in 2024.<sup>14</sup> This represents nearly 4 percent of the average bill today for a residential customer with overhead electric service.<sup>15</sup>

CUB agrees with Xcel that these investments have the potential to provide benefits that outweigh their substantial costs. However, as we previously noted, “experience has shown that these investments are inherently complex and can be subject to cost overruns. In addition, the customer-facing value proposition identified at the outset of a project is not often realized upon implementation.”<sup>16</sup>

Clear processes and standards are critical to evaluating such proposals. The functionalities, costs, and benefits of proposed investments, and their costs compared with alternatives, must be established prior to their approval, and metrics must be established in order to later evaluate the degree to which any approved investments delivered promised benefits for ratepayers.

Xcel’s AMI and FAN investments have traveled a complex and often unclear regulatory path to date. We concur with Synapse in its report for the Department, that “[u]sing multiple regulatory processes and dockets to review grid modernization investments creates regulatory uncertainty and ambiguity that can lead to inefficient and less effective oversight by the Commission and stakeholders.”<sup>17</sup> It has been unclear to CUB precisely which questions would be taken up by the Commission at each stage of this process, and we have, at times, spent substantial time on analysis that were apparently not helpful to the Commission at the times it was presented. For example, we and other parties submitted recommendations on procedure in Dockets 19-666 and 20-680, and we now revisit some of the same questions in the present proceeding. Further, full participation in these proceedings requires expertise that CUB—and, we believe, most other parties—does not have in house. We have engaged outside experts when possible, but that is resource intensive and is particularly difficult when the timing and scope of proceedings are unclear.

### III. Recommendations

CUB has previously argued, and we continue to believe, that a contested case is most appropriate for the consideration of Xcel’s AMI and FAN projects.<sup>18</sup>

Xcel has argued that “a contested case is not warranted” and that “the Company is unaware of any applicable statute or rule providing a right to a contested case.”<sup>19</sup> However, by its plain language, Minn.

Rule 7829.1000 does not state that a contested case referral must be predicated on a statute or rule providing a right to a contested case hearing; it states that the Commission “*shall*” refer a matter to a contested case hearing if either of the following two conditions are present: (1) “a proceeding involves contested material facts and there is a right to a hearing under statute or rule” or (2) “the commission finds that all significant issues have not been resolved to its satisfaction.” While we believe that the Commission can find that both are true in this case, the Commission need only make one of these findings.

As CUB has stated:

[S]ignificant issues remain unresolved in the record. Cost recovery for the AGIS investments requires complex and detailed consideration of a large number of additional questions, many of which are quite technical in nature and regard types of utility technology and opportunities that have not previously been considered by Minnesota regulators or parties. [T]his investment will have a substantial customer impact. Such a complex and significant topic merits, if anything, greater consideration than typical.<sup>20</sup> [...]

This is a complex and new area of investment with substantial risk that costs will run over-budget or that expected benefits will fail to be realized.<sup>21</sup>

The scope of the cost recovery proceeding will necessarily be extensive to “provide a full understanding of the investments, their functionalities, and their costs, and how these compare to alternatives, as well as the mechanisms to keep customer costs low,” including a thorough understanding of “the discrete costs and values of discrete, optional functionalities included in the meters, such as their distributed intelligence capabilities,” and when and how functionalities will be used by Xcel and made available to third parties.<sup>22</sup>

A right to a hearing is provided under statute. Minn. Stat. 216A.03, Subd. 7 states:

A filing with the commission may be deemed approved by the commission after 60 days of filing, unless the commission, a commissioner, or any other person requests the filing be set aside for action by the commission. The commission may designate, by standing order, categories or types of filings that are eligible for approval under this subdivision. [...] [P]etitions to increase rates are not eligible for designation.<sup>23</sup>

In this matter, CUB is a “person request[ing] the filing be set aside for action by the commission.” Moreover, Minn. Stat. 216.16 provides for a hearing for matters not deemed approved: “If the matter be not adjusted to the satisfaction of the commission, it shall set a time and place of a hearing, and give at least ten days’ notice thereof to each party.”

Finally, CUB believes that the upcoming comment period regarding Xcel's Transmission Cost Recovery ("TCR") petition in this docket should not examine Xcel's AMI and FAN proposals. The Commission's July 23, 2020 Order in Docket No. E002/M-19-666 was clear in its statement that "[t]he Commission will make a procedural and scoping decision prior to the consideration of a rider recovery determination."<sup>24</sup> CUB continues to have concerns about the use of rider recovery for these investments. As we detailed in our comments in Xcel's 2019 IDP, the use of riders undermines a multiyear rate plan's purpose to provide a cost control incentive and may obscure the true financial impact to customers, diminish the transparent accounting of distribution system costs in rates, and lead to double recovery – all of which are particularly important in the context of a potential bill increase of nearly 4% for an average customer.<sup>25</sup>

As a side note, CUB wishes to share with the Commission that we are unlikely to be able to participate in a contested case, or in a detailed examination of Xcel's AMI and FAN proposals through any procedure. As a small nonprofit organization, we do not have the resources to engage the necessary experts at this time. We do not believe this affects the Commission's decision in any way but wish to share our position in the interest of full transparency.

#### IV. Conclusion

For the reasons described above, CUB respectfully recommends:

1. The Commission bifurcate cost recovery decisions related to AGIS and non-AGIS costs.
2. The Commission refer Xcel's AGIS-related costs to the Office of Administrative Hearings for a contested case examining the proposed investments and the procedure for cost recovery.
