Commissioner Tuma proposes the following decision options:

Tuma New 12A. Should EPA decide to issue a final denial of the Part B alternative liner application for Coal Creek, GRE shall make a compliance filing in this docket within 30 days on the potential impact to the expansion plan if there are limitations to station operations. If the action is taken by the federal government within six months of the filing of GRE's next resource plan this compliance requirement can be addressed in that future plan.

Or

Tuma New 12B. Should any federal rule significantly alter the operations of any of GRE's facilities or impact a facility that provides electricity to GRE through a PPA GRE shall make a compliance filing in this docket within 30 days on the potential impact to the expansion plan. A significant impact for this compliance filing would be any action that causes a reduction in the MISO capacity accreditation of a unit of greater than 50 MW in a future MISO's summer and winter seasons. If the action is taken by the federal government within six months of the filing of GRE's next resource plan this compliance requirement can be addressed in that future plan.
