Dear Dr. Haar:

Please find enclosed Minnesota Pipe Line Company, LLC's ("MPL" or "Company") proposed notice plan, as required by Minnesota Rule 7829.2560 (the "Notice Plan"). The Notice Plan details the manner in which MPL will provide notice to all persons reasonably likely to be affected by its Minnesota Pipe Line Reliability Project (the "Project").

Minnesota Rule 7829.2560 requires this Notice Plan to be filed at least three months before MPL may pursue a Certificate of Need ("CON") for the Project. Accordingly, MPL intends to pursue a CON for this Project at some point after the three months has elapsed.

The Project is needed to ensure that Minnesota refineries continue to have access to reliable and sufficient crude oil supplies to meet demand for transportation fuels. MPL plans to use available capacity on its newest pipeline - Line 4 - to ensure the reliability of its pipeline system, which is the primary crude oil pipeline system supplying Minnesota's two refineries. These refineries produce much of the transportation fuels used throughout Minnesota and the Upper Midwest.

The addition of six pump stations to MPL Line 4 and upgrades at the existing stations will allow the pipeline to operate at its original design capacity of approximately 350,000 barrels of crude oil per day when needed to meet demand. The Project will give MPL the flexibility to shift capacity to its newest pipeline in the event of an outage on other segments of the pipeline system. It will also allow MPL to conduct maintenance on its other pipelines as needed without disrupting crude supplies to Minnesota refineries. As previously approved by the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission, MPL Line 4 is already capable of handling the additional capacity,

so the Project will only require the addition of six pump stations and the upgrade of stations along the current MPL Line 4 route.

The work will occur solely on six small parcels of land already owned by or to be purchased by MPL along the pipeline, along with work at current MPL stations. It will not require any change to the pipeline itself or to its routing.

In accordance with Minnesota Rule 7829.2560, copies of this filing have been served on the Department of Commerce's Division of Energy Resources and Office of Energy Security, the Attorney General's Antitrust and Utilities Division, the Attorney General's Residential and Small Business Utilities Division, and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, St. Paul District.

### I. INTRODUCTION

Minnesota Pipe Line Company, LLC ("MPL" or "Company") submits this Notice Plan to the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") as required by Minnesota Rule 7829.2560. MPL plans to use available capacity on its newest pipeline - Line 4 - to ensure the overall reliability of its pipeline system (the "Project"). The MPL system is the primary pipeline system that supplies crude oil to the two Twin Cities

refineries which produce much of the transportation fuels used in Minnesota and throughout the Upper Midwest.

The Project is needed to ensure that the two Minnesota refineries continue to have access to reliable and sufficient crude oil supplies to meet demand for transportation fuels.

The addition of six pump stations to MPL Line 4 and upgrades at existing stations will allow the pipeline to operate at its original design capacity of approximately 350,000 barrels of crude oil per day when needed to meet demand. This Project will give MPL the flexibility to shift capacity to its newest pipeline in the event of an outage on other segments of the pipeline system. In addition, this Project will allow for MPL to conduct maintenance on other segments of the pipeline system as needed without disrupting crude supplies to the Twin Cities refineries. As previously approved by the Commission, MPL Line 4 is already capable of handling the additional capacity, so the Project will only require the addition of pump stations along the current MPL Line 4 route. An overview map of MPL Line 4, the existing pump stations and the approximate locations of the planned new substations is attached as Exhibit A.

MPL intends to apply for a Certificate of Need ("CON"), which would allow it to construct new pump stations and upgrade current stations along the MPL Line 4 pipeline.

MPL hopes to have the Project completed by 2018.

The Project will increase the capacity of MPL Line 4 - originally completed in 2008 and formerly referred to as the "MinnCan Project" - from approximately 165,000 barrels per day to approximately 350,000 barrels per day. The Project requires a CON

under Minnesota Rule 7853.0030 because it will expand the capacity of the pipeline more than 20% in two years.

Under Minnesota Rule 7829.2560, MPL must submit and seek approval for its Notice Plan at least three months before applying for a CON. Accordingly, MPL submits this Notice Plan for the Commission's approval.

#### II. PROPOSED NOTICE PLAN

## A. Direct Mail Notice to Landowners (Minn. R. 7829.2560, Subp. 3(A)).

Enclosed as Exhibits B and C are proposed notices to all landowners that may be affected by the Project. Although no landowners will be directly impacted because the Project only requires construction on land already owned or to be purchased by MPL, Exhibit B will be provided to all landowners with property through which MPL Line 4 runs, and Exhibit C will be provided to landowners with property that abuts the land on which the six pump stations will be constructed.

# B. Direct Mail Notice to all Mailing Addresses (Minn. R. 7829.2560, Subp. 3(B)).

Similar to Section A above, Exhibit B will be provided to mailing addresses through which MPL Line 4 runs and Exhibit C will be provided to mailing addresses that abut the land on which the six pump stations will be constructed.

# C. Direct Mail Notice to Local Governments (Minn. R. 7829.2560, Subp. 3(C)).

Again, although the Project will require work only at the pump station locations and on land already owned or to be purchased by MPL, enclosed as Exhibit D is a proposed notice to tribal governments and to the governments of towns, statutory cities, home rule charter cities, and counties in those jurisdictions that may be affected by the

Project. In addition to these entities, Exhibit D will be provided to state senators, state representatives, U.S. senators, and U.S. representatives whose districts include constituents who may be affected by the Project. A list of government officials to receive the proposed notice is attached as Exhibit E.

# D. Published Notice (Minn. R. 7829.2560, Subp. 3(D)).

Enclosed as Exhibit F is a proposed notice to be published in newspapers in areas reasonably that may be affected by the Project. The list of newspapers to receive the proposed notice is attached as Exhibit G.

# **E.** Content of the Proposed Notices.

As required by Minnesota Rule 7829.2560, subp. 4, the notices in Exhibits B-E will include the following information related to the Project:

- a map showing the end points of the pipeline and existing related pipelines and related facilities in the area;
- a description of general right-of-way requirements for the Project and a statement that the applicant intends to acquire property rights for the right-of-way that the proposed pipeline will require;
- a notice that the Project cannot be constructed unless the Commission certifies that it is needed;
- the Commission's mailing address, telephone number, and website;
- a brief explanation of how to get on the mailing list for the Commission's proceeding; and
- a statement that requests for certification of pipelines are governed by Minnesota Law, including specifically Chapters 7851, 7853, and 7855 and Minnesota Statutes, Section 216B.243.

# F. Notice Time Frame.

MPL must, under Minnesota Rule 7829.2560, subp. 6, implement the proposed Notice Plan within 30 days of the Commission's approval. MPL intends to comply with this timeframe.

## III. CONCLUSION.


Because the proposed Notice Plan complies with all applicable rules, MPL respectfully requests that the Commission approve the Notice Plan.

Certificate of Need Application for Minnesota Pipe Line Reliability Project

Minnesota Pipe Line Company, LLC ("MPL") is planning to use available capacity on its newest pipeline - Line 4 (formally known as MinnCan) - to ensure the overall reliability of its pipeline system (the "Project"). The MPL system is the primary pipeline system that supplies crude oil to the two Twin Cities refineries which produce much of the transportation fuels used in Minnesota and throughout the Upper Midwest.

The Project is needed to ensure that the two Minnesota refineries continue to have access to reliable and sufficient crude oil supplies to meet demand for transportation fuels.

The addition of six pump stations to MPL Line 4 and upgrades at existing stations will allow the pipeline to operate at its original design capacity of approximately 350,000 barrels of crude oil per day when needed to meet demand. This Project will give MPL the flexibility to shift capacity to its newest pipeline in the event of an outage on other segments of the pipeline system. In addition, this Project will allow for MPL to conduct maintenance on other segments of the pipeline system as needed without disrupting crude supplies to the Twin Cities refineries.

As previously approved by the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission ("Commission"), MPL Line 4 is already capable of handling the additional capacity, so the Project will only require the addition of pump stations along the current MPL Line 4 route.

In order to increase MPL Line 4's capacity from approximately 165,000 barrels per day to approximately 350,000 barrels per day, MPL plans to construct six pump stations and upgrade existing stations. The new pump stations will be located in rural areas along the route in the counties of Hubbard, Wadena, Morrison, Meeker, McLeod and Scott. No new pipeline will be installed and no new pipeline right-of-way will be acquired for this Project. MPL Line 4 is already capable of handling the additional capacity, so additional work on these pump stations is the only construction necessary to complete the upgrade. If approved by the Commission, MPL intends for the Project to be completed by 2018.

This notice is intended to provide you with details about the reliability project and notify you regarding how you can participate in the Commission's review process. The reliability project cannot be started until the Commission determines it is needed and issues a Certificate of Need. MPL's request for a Certificate of Need is governed by Minnesota Law, including Chapters 7851, 7853, and 7855, and Minnesota Statutes, Section 216B.243.
