Efforts taken to meet the objective and standards

East River, through its supplemental power supplier, Basin Electric Power Cooperative, since 2001 has participated in the development of over 700 MW of wind resources to supply member load. Basin Electric Power Cooperative has executed purchased power contracts for an additional 376 MWs of wind resources to be operational by 2016.

Obstacles encountered or anticipated in meeting the objective or standards

The obstacles to deploying renewable energy resources include: a lack of consistent federal tax incentives for renewables, limited federal tax incentives for entities with non-profit or cooperative business models, and challenges siting and building new transmission facilities and utility infrastructure. Due to the intermittent nature of renewables and national/state policies limiting generation options for utilities, utilities are forced to rely more and more on natural gas-fired generation, and this over-reliance on one fuel source, which is heavily utilized in other sectors, could have a serious impact on consumers if natural gas supply becomes scarce or prices rise.

Potential solutions include a revision of federal tax incentives for renewable energy generation, common sense national and state policies that not only protect the environment but also protect consumers from adverse rate impacts of such policies, recognition of waste heat and large hydroelectric facilities as eligible renewable energy resources to meet the Minnesota standard, and state and federal policy that support infrastructure development as well as increased collaborative efforts such as the successful CapX 2020 projects.

Identify efforts taken to adequately protect against undesirable economic impacts on ratepayers, including, but not limited to keeping customer's bills and the utility's rates as low as practicable, given regulatory and other constraints.

The expected growth of distributed generation raises serious policy issues regarding how consumers pay for utility infrastructure. Higher-income and commercial consumers are more likely to avail themselves of distributed generation opportunities than lower-income and residential customers. Under most DG scenarios, the utility will still be expected to provide supplemental power and/or buy the output of the DG. This will require utility infrastructure to be in place. If public policy or rate structures fail to adequately recognize the costs of this infrastructure as well as other related costs and fail to properly assign those costs, then the remaining customers will unfairly bear additional costs related to another customer's DG project. While this would be inequitable to any customer, the financial impact will be most acute for consumers who are lower-income, fixed-income, or renting their homes. While East River supports renewable energy and distributed generation, the movement to spur such projects must be done in a manner that does not unfairly shift costs to other consumers.

East River's previously stated concern about the increasing reliance on natural-gas fired generation creates serious issues for ratepayers particularly if supply becomes scare or prices rise.
