JOINT APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT UNDER § 252(i)

Hiawatha Broadband Communications, Inc. ("HBC") and CenturyTel of Minnesota, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink ("CenturyLink") hereby submit to the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") this Application for approval of the enclosed Negotiated Interconnection Agreement ("Agreement") executed March 10, 2016, between HBC and CenturyLink. In support of this Application, the parties state as follows:

I.

HBC is incorporated in the State of Minnesota and received certification with the State of Minnesota on March 20, 2000.

II.

CenturyLink is a Minnesota corporation and an incumbent local exchange carrier in Minnesota.

On March 10, 2016, HBC and CenturyLink entered into an Agreement pursuant to § 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 to adopt the interconnection agreement between CenturyTel of Minnesota, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink and US Link Inc. d/b/a TDS Metrocom. The Agreement is premised upon CenturyTel of Minnesota d/b/a CenturyLink's agreement with US Link, Inc. d/b/a TDS Metrocom approved by the Commission on April 8, 2014, in Docket No. P-465, 551/IC-14-194. This Agreement is submitted for approval pursuant to § 252(e) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended by the Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("Act"). A copy of the Agreement is attached.

IV.

In accordance with §252(e) of the Act, the parties submit that this Agreement provides no basis for a finding of discrimination or contravention of the public interest.

First, the Agreement does not discriminate against any other telecommunications carrier. Further, CenturyLink is offering the same terms contained in the Agreement to all other interested carriers.

Second, the Agreement is consistent with the public interest as identified in the procompetitive policies of the Commission, the State of Minnesota, the FCC, and the United States Congress. The Agreement will permit resale of CenturyLink's services consistent with the Act and the rules and regulations of this Commission. Expeditious approval of the Agreement will facilitate immediate competition in CenturyLink's local exchange services in Minnesota.

In the interests of bringing the benefits of this agreement to the telecommunications customers of Minnesota as soon as possible, CenturyLink and HBC request the Commission issue its order approving the Agreement at the earliest possible date.

Adoption of the Interconnection Agreement

This Adoption of the Interconnection Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into by and between CenturyTel of Minnesota, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink ("CenturyLink") and Hiawatha Broadband Communications, Inc.

("CLEC"), each of which may be referred to herein as "Party", or collectively as "the Parties", to establish the terms, conditions and rates for local interconnection and the exchange of Local traffic for the State of Minnesota.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

1. ADOPTED AGREEMENT

- 1.1 This Agreement between the Parties shall consist of the Interconnection Agreement entered into by and between CenturyTel of Minnesota, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink and US Link Inc., d/b/a TDS Metrocom that was approved by the Commission in April 8, 2014 ("Adopted Agreement").
- 1.2 This Agreement is made a part of and incorporates the terms and conditions of the Adopted Agreement, including all amendments to that Adopted Agreement (the "Terms").
- 1.3 Except as set forth herein, the Adopted Agreement remains unchanged and in full force and effect. In the event of a conflict between the Terms of the Adopted Agreement and this Agreement, this Agreement will control.

2. PARTY

For the purposes of this Agreement, CLEC is hereby substituted in the Adopted Agreement for Hutchison Telecommunications, Inc.

3. PROVISIONS

- 3.1 The Terms of the US Link Inc., d/b/a TDS Metrocom Agreement are being adopted in its entirety by CLEC pursuant to CLEC's statutory rights under Section 252(i). The filing and performance by CenturyLink of the Terms does not in any way constitute a waiver by CenturyLink of any position as to the Terms or a portion thereof, nor does it constitute a waiver by CenturyLink of any or all rights and remedies it may have to seek review of the Terms, or to seek review in any way of any provisions included in these Terms as a result of CLEC's 252(i) election.
- 3.2 Should CLEC attempt to apply the adopted Terms in a manner that conflicts with the provisions set forth herein, CenturyLink reserves its rights to seek appropriate legal and/or equitable relief.
- 3.3 CLEC understands that it is providing a representation and warrants that it is complying with all provisions of the Adopted Agreement as of the effective date of the adoption.

4. EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERM

- 4.1 This Agreement, if an initial Agreement shall become effective on the date of Commission Approval ("Effective Date"); however the Parties may agree to implement the provisions of this Agreement upon execution by both Parties. However, the initiation of a new account, any new provision of service or obligation or any revision to currently existing services or obligations may take up to 60 days to accommodate any required initial processes.
- 4.2 In the event that the Parties currently have an existing Interconnection Agreement, this Agreement shall replace the existing Interconnection Agreement in its entirety beginning on the Effective Date. However, nothing relieves the Parties from fulfilling all obligations incurred under that prior Interconnection Agreement.

4.3 The expiration date of this Adoption Agreement shall be the same as the expiration date of the agreement that is being adopted, which is March 24, 2017.
