On June 28th, 2016 the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Comment Period on Minor Alteration Application regarding the Minnesota – Iowa 345kV Transmission Line Project in Jackson, Martin and Faribault Counties. The Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) has reviewed the application and submits the following comments in response to the Notice.

MnDOT appreciates the opportunity to comment on the Minor Alteration Application. As stated in our Scoping Comment letter submitted on August 3rd, 2013, highway crossings by utilities, such as this proposed crossing of US 169, do not pose insurmountable difficulties in issuing a permit. These permits usually have conditions associated with them, such as ensuring that the wires are high enough that they will not pose a hazard to highway users or maintenance employees. Highway crossings should occur as close to right angles as possible with pole placement located an adequate distance from the highway right of way.

Should this alteration be approved, coordination and permitting efforts for this portion of the project should be done through MnDOT's District 7A Engineering Specialist, Steve Schoeb. Steve can be reached at 507-304-6180 or Steve-Schoeb@state.mn.us.
