Dear Minnesota Public Utilities Commission:

United Natural Gas, LLC (UNG) filed a Petition for Exemption for Small Gas Utility Franchise (Docket G-6960/M-16-214) on March 8, 2016. A Final Rates/Services & Regulations Book (incorporating recommendations from the Department of Commerce and in compliance with the May 24, 2016 Order) was also filed.

Since the filing of the above-stated documents, UNG has been requested by the Lower Sioux Indian Community in the State of Minnesota, a federally recognized Indian tribe to supply Natural Gas to their community. They have also requested a position on the rate board shown in Section 2.

With the additional load UNG will not be serving more than 2,000 customers.

An amended Section 2 to the final Rates/Services & Regulations Book is attached. Along with the map of the Lower Sioux Indian Community facilities under attachment B, System Maps.

United Farmers Cooperative ("UFC") is an agricultural cooperative located in Winthrop, Minnesota. Any agricultural producer who does at least \$5,000 of business with UFC annually is a voting member of UFC. Although United Natural Gas, LLC is a separate business entity, it is wholly owned by UFC and for membership purposes, a qualifying patron of UNG is deemed a member of UFC. Therefore, eligible UNG patrons are voting members in UFC and they possess the same governance rights as if they did business directly with UFC. In many cases, UNG patrons may already be members because, assuming they are agricultural producers, they may already purchase feed, agronomy products, refined petroleum products or L.P. Gas products from UFC.
