PERMIT COMPLIANCE FILING REVIEW

PUC Docket No. <u>IP6851/WS-10-1238</u>

Big Blue Wind Farm, LLC (Permittee) filed the following compliance document pertaining to the Site Permit¹ issued by the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) on August 17, 2011, for the Big Blue Wind Farm Project (Project). The filing applies to conditions within the Avian and Bat Protection Plan (ABPP)² developed for the Project.

Avian and Bat Protection Plan

Section 6.7 of the Site Permit states: "The Permittee shall prepare an Avian and Bat Protection Plan in consultation with the Commission, DNR, and the United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS). The plan shall be approved by the Commission prior to construction. The plan shall address next steps to be taken to identify and mitigate impacts to avian and bat species during the construction phase and the operation phase of the Project. The plan shall also include formal and informal monitoring, training, wildlife handling, documentation (e.g., photographs), and reporting protocols for each phase of the Project."

Avian and Bat Protection Plan Special Provisions

Section 13.1 of the Site Permit states: "The Avian and Bat Protection Plan in Section 6.7 shall include an Eagle Protection Plan and survey plans and protocols to conduct post-construction bald eagle surveys. The post-construction bald eagle surveys shall be conducted for a minimum of one year. The results of the post-construction bald eagle survey shall be submitted to the

Commission. Based on those results, the Commission may modify conditions in this permit pursuant to Section 11.2."

The Big Blue Wind Energy Project ABPP³ was completed on January 3, 2012, and later efiled on September 9, 2013. A Post-Construction Avian and Bat Studies Protocol document⁴, dated May 9, 2013, was developed by the Permittee in coordination with DOC-EERA and Department of Natural Resources (DNR).

Throughout 2013 the Permittee conducted post-construction avian and bat studies as identified in the May 9, 2013 protocols document, submitted quarterly reports; April 2013⁵, July 2013⁶, October 2013⁷, January 2014⁸, and submitted an Annual Report⁹.

EERA Comments

As noted above, the Permittee has conducted the first year of post-construction avian and bat studies as identified in the Project's ABPP and protocols document, and reporting has been timely to date. DOC-EERA and DNR have reviewed the Annual Report efiled on February 28, 2014. DOC-EERA staff will be working with the Permittee to revise the Annual Report, and ultimately resubmit the revised Annual Report.

The Permittee will continue to conduct post-construction fatality monitoring and postconstruction eagle nest and use monitoring, throughout 2014, as identified in the ABPP and protocols document, while the 2013 Annual Report is being revised and resubmitted.
