This letter is to address the progress which has been made at Turbines 8 and 9 since Tuesday, September 26.

- Tuesday, September 26 Weather Delay: Lightning and high winds.
- Wednesday, September 27
 Lifting equipment installed on blades.
 Engineering tested craneless components and took measurements.
- Thursday, September 28
 Rotor lowered to the ground.
 Surfaces cleaned and shims glued to rotor.
- Friday, September 29
 Rotor flown and reattached.
 Lifting equipment removed.
 Crane walked to turbine 9.
- Saturday, September 30

Turbine returned to service. Gen speed test conducted. No clicking noise observed.

- Monday, October 2
 Preparation begun on T9.
 Hoisted tooling.
- Tuesday, October 3 Weather Delay: Thunderstorms and Lightning.
- Wednesday, October 4
 Rotor lowered to the ground.
 Surfaces cleaned and shims glued to rotor.
 Rotor flown and reattached.
 Lifting equipment removed.
- Thursday, October 5
 Organized tooling and equipment.
 Start the return to service work.
 Weather interruption: Lightning delay.

Big Blue will continue to update the plan and progress of repairs until the repairs are complete at wind turbines 8 and 9.
