

The Post Construction Noise Analysis Report drafted by WSB, in my opinion, has false and fabricated results. On page 10 of their report they give the results from Microphone 2 (M2). This microphone was not working most of the 20 days they had it in the road ditch.

The most important false fabrication happened on June 24th and June 25th. The microphone that was on the flimsy tripod tipped over and was lying in the ditch upside down. I took a picture of the microphone laying in the ditch at 5:20 pm on June 25th. However, the results from the WSB study shows this same microphone that was lying in the ditch was recording sound levels. As a matter of fact they say the LAeq was 70 db at the very same time the microphone was laying down on the ground in the grassy road ditch. I then contacted Charlie to tell him his microphone was lying in the ditch, he went out and straighten it up later that day or the next day; I didn't see him fix it.


