REQUEST FOR VARIANCE - BILLING ERROR RULES

Dear Mr. Wolf:

Northern States Power Company, doing business as Xcel Energy, submits this Reply to the February 5, 2018 Comments of the Minnesota Department of Commerce, Division of Energy Resources on our request for a one-time variance to billing error rules in the matter referenced above.

We appreciate the Department's recommendation that the Commission approve our request. In response to the Department's request for clarification, a "non-billing rate" is an internal term and concept we use in circumstances when we only need to monitor, rather than bill, the consumption or output of a meter. For example, with a reactive meter that is only needed to calculate a power factor, or when a customer has a time-of-day meter, but is not on a time-of-day rate.

We respectfully request the Commission approve our request as supplemented by this Reply. We have electronically filed this document with the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission, and copies have been served on the parties on the attached service list.
