As of October 31, 2016, the subscriber access line count was 47,724. This figure is based on the approach directed by the Commission for the 911/TAP/TAM surcharge, reflecting the number of subscriber access lines, network access lines for Centrex, and trunk channels. This figure represents the number of access lines, but it is important to note that the statute refers to "subscribers" rather than access lines. Obviously, the number of subscribers is less than the number of total access lines.

Please provide the last date Frontier Communications of Minnesota, Inc.'s subscriber line count was greater than 50,000.
