- **Issue:** 1. Should the Commission approve the requests for ETC Designation or update of ETC authority in Minnesota for purposes of applying CAF II funds in Minnesota?
 - 2. Should the Commission take any other actions in this matter?

Background:

The Commission has been informed that companies which have won the FCC Connect America Fund (CAF) II reverse auction for certain census blocks in Minnesota must have their requests for Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) status, or necessary updates to existing ETC status, approved by February 25, 2019 in order to receive those funds.

Please reference Docket No. P999/CI-18-634 in your filing. Upon filing, each petitioner will be assigned a unique docket number.

Failure to submit a timely and complete petition by October 31, 2018 may result in the Commission being unable to determine the status of the petition before the February 25, 2019 deadline.

Filing Requirements: Utilities, telecommunications carriers, official parties, and state agencies are **required** to file documents using the Commission's electronic filing system (eFiling). All parties, participants and interested persons are encouraged to use eFiling: <u>mn.gov/puc</u>, select *eFiling*, and follow the prompts.
