DODGE COUNTY WIND, LLC'S MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Dodge County Wind, LLC ("DCW") respectfully requests that the procedural schedule in the above-referenced dockets be immediately suspended.

On August 9, 2019, DCW withdrew its MISO interconnection queue position no. J441, because of the significant interconnection costs associated with that queue position. Therefore, DCW requests a suspension of the procedural schedule to provide it time to assess the Dodge County Wind Project's ("Project") point of interconnection, make any necessary updates to its

wind facility site permit and certificate of need applications, and consult with the parties on a

revised procedural schedule.

Concurrent with this filing, DCW is also filing a request with the Minnesota Public

Utilities Commission ("Commission") to withdraw the transmission route permit application,

given the need to find a new point of interconnection for the Project. Suspending the procedural

schedule will provide the Commission time to act on the withdrawal request. Accordingly,

DCW requests that the procedural schedule be suspended.

On or before September 4, 2019, DCW will file, as needed, any amendments or updates

to its wind facility site permit and certificate of need applications. At that time, DCW will also,

after consulting with the parties, submit a proposed procedural schedule for continuing the

proceedings for the site permit and certificate of need applications.
