On behalf of Dodge County Wind, LLC ("DCW"), enclosed please find an updated Large Wind Energy Conversion System ("LWECS") Site Permit Application and relevant appendices and maps, as well as an updated Certificate of Need Application for the Dodge County Wind Project ("Updated Applications"). Specifically, the Updated Applications include the following:

- **LWECS Site Permit Application**
- Redline of Changes to the LWECS Site Permit Application
- LWECS Site Permit Application Maps 4, 7, 8, 9, 12 and 13
- LWECS Site Permit Application Appendices D, E, and F
- Certificate of Need Application
- Redline of Changes to the Certificate of Need Application

The purpose of the Updated Applications is to provide the Commission with revised information regarding the Dodge County Wind Project following DCW's August 14, 2019 request to withdraw its Application for a Route Permit for the associated 345-kV transmission line in MPUC Docket IP-6981/TL-308. In addition to removing information regarding the transmission line, the Updated Applications make the following updates: (1) the identification of the safe harbor turbines to be used if construction occurs in 2021, and (2) additional information on need, given that the off-taker may change. Overall, these updates are minimal and support the continued review and approval of the Site Permit and Certificate of Need Applications.
