We appreciate the well written briefing papers and decision options. We wanted to give you a heads up that Xcel, MP, OTP and the Department, are in agreement for Commission agenda item #4 regarding the Schedule Extension for the 2021 Fuel Forecast.

We support decision options 2 and 4, which would extend MP's Reply Comments deadline from July 31 to August 28 as request by MP.

Additionally, we would support Xcel's & OTP's Reply Comments deadline also being extended from July 31 to August 28, although Utilities are welcome to file sooner that August 28. The Department would also like to extend the Department's Response Comments deadline from August 31 to September 28 – basically add the same 28 days to our deadline based on Utilities extension to Reply Comments.

Under the existing schedule the Commission's Order is tentatively due November 30, 2020, however, MP, OTP & Xcel agree to a mid-December timeframe for a written Commission Order, as long as we have a verbal approval of the forecasted rates by December 1. This would allow MP, OTP & Xcel to publish the rates on December 1 and still provide a 30-day notice for customers.
