Notice of Filing of Certificate of Need, Site Permit, and Route Permit Applications for the Big Bend Wind Project and Certificate of Need and Site Permit Applications for the Red Rock Solar Project

Please take notice that Big Bend Wind, LLC (Big Bend) and Red Rock Solar, LLC (Red Rock), subsidiaries of Apex Clean Energy Holdings, LLC (Apex), filed applications for Minnesota's first potential wind-solar utility-scale hybrid renewable project in Cottonwood, Watonwan, and Martin Counties, Minnesota with the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) on November 9, 2020. Big Bend filed Certificate of Need (CN) and Site Permit (SP) applications for an up to 308 megawatt (MW) large wind energy conversion system and associated facilities to be located in Cottonwood and Watonwan Counties, Minnesota (Wind Project); Red Rock filed CN and SP applications for an up to 60 MW solar energy conversion facility and associated facilities in Cottonwood County, Minnesota (Solar Project). Additionally, Big Bend filed a Route Permit application for a proposed 18-mile long 161 kilovolt (kV) transmission line proposed in Cottonwood, Martin, and Watonwan Counties, Minnesota needed to interconnect the projects to the transmission grid (Transmission Line). Big Bend and Red Rock have requested joint proceedings for the applications.

#### PROJECT LOCATION

The total renewable energy generation could consist of up to 335 MW of renewable energy (275 MW of wind and 60 MW of solar), or up to 308 MW of only wind.

The Wind Project footprint spans approximately 43,523 acres in portions of Delton, Selma, Carson, and Midway Townships in Cottonwood County and Butterfield Township in Watonwan County. Big Bend has not made a final selection of wind turbine generators but is proposing to utilize between 54 and 55 turbines, ranging from 5.5 to 5.7 MW per turbine. In addition to the wind turbines, the Wind Project will consist of an electrical collection system, access roads, a permanent meteorological tower, an operations and maintenance facility, one substation, and other infrastructure typical of a wind farm.

The Solar Project is within the boundaries of the proposed Wind Project site, spanning approximately 846 acres in Midway Township, Cottonwood County, Minnesota. The Solar Project will include solar panels and racking, inverters, security fencing, a substation, electrical collection and communication lines, stormwater basins, laydown areas, and up to three weather stations.

The Transmission Line will consist of approximately 18 miles of 161 kV transmission line located in portions of Midway, Mountain Lake, Odin, and Cedar townships in Cottonwood, Martin, and Watonwan Counties, Minnesota. The Transmission Line will connect the Wind Project and the Solar Project to an existing 345 kV transmission line near Xcel Energy Crandall Switching Station in Martin County, Minnesota.

The accompanying map outlines the location of the Wind Project, Solar Project, and Transmission Line.





To: Persons interested in the proposed up to 308 MW large wind energy conversion system and associated facilities to be located in Cottonwood and Watonwan Counties, Minnesota (Big Bend Wind Project); persons interested in the proposed up to 60 MW solar energy conversion facility and associated facilities in Cottonwood County, Minnesota (Red Rock Solar Project); persons interested in the proposed 18-mile long 161 kV transmission line proposed in Cottonwood, Martin, and Watonwan Counties, Minnesota needed to interconnect the Big Bend Wind Project and the Red Rock Solar Project to the transmission grid; the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission Energy Facilities General List; Local Officials; and Property Owners

Re: Notice of Big Bend Wind, LLC's Filing of Certificate of Need, Site Permit, and Route Permit Applications with the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (MPUC Docket No. IP7013/CN-19-408/WS-19-619/TL-19-621) and Red Rock Solar, LLC's Filing of Certificate of Need and Site Permit Applications with the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (MPUC Docket Nos. IP7014/CN-19-486/GS-19-620).

This letter provides formal notice that Big Bend Wind, LLC ("Big Bend") and Red Rock Solar, LLC ("Red Rock"), subsidiaries of Apex Clean Energy Holdings, LLC ("Apex"), filed requisite applications for Minnesota's first potential wind-solar utility-scale hybrid renewable project in Cottonwood and Watonwan Counties, Minnesota with the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") on November 9, 2020. Big Bend filed Certificate of Need ("CN") and Site Permit ("SP") applications for an up to 308 megawatt ("MW") large wind energy conversion system and associated facilities to be located in Cottonwood and Watonwan Counties, Minnesota ("Wind Project"); Red Rock filed CN and SP applications for an up to 60 MW solar energy conversion facility and associated facilities in Cottonwood County, Minnesota ("Solar Project"). Additionally, Big Bend filed a Route Permit application for a proposed 18-mile long 161 kV transmission line proposed in Cottonwood, Martin, and Watonwan Counties, Minnesota needed to interconnect the Big Bend Wind Project and the Red Rock Solar Project to the transmission grid.

#### PROJECT LOCATION

As proposed, the total renewable energy generation could consist of up to 335 MW of renewable energy (275 MW of wind and 60 MW of solar), or up to 308 MW of only wind.

The Big Bend Wind Project footprint spans approximately 43,523 acres in portions of Delton, Selma, Carson, and Midway Townships in Cottonwood County and Butterfield Township in Watonwan County. Big Bend has not made a final selection of wind turbine generators but is proposing to utilize between 54 and 55 turbines, ranging from 5.5 to 5.7 MW per turbine. In addition to the wind turbines, the Big Bend Wind Project will consist of an electrical collection

system, access roads, a permanent meteorological tower, an operations and maintenance facility, one Project substation, sonic Detection and Ranging or Light Detection and Ranging unit, one laydown area, aboveground electrical feeder line, up to four Aircraft Detection Lighting Systems radars one temporary batch plant area, if needed, for construction of the Project, and other infrastructure typical of a wind farm.

The Red Rock Solar Project is within the boundaries of the proposed Big Bend Wind Project site, spanning approximately 846 acres in Midway Township, Cottonwood County, Minnesota. The Red Rock Solar Project will include solar panels and racking, inverters, security fencing, a Solar Project Substation, electrical collection and communication lines, stormwater basins, laydown areas, and up to three weather stations.

The Transmission Line is needed to interconnect the Wind Project and the Solar Project to the transmission grid. The Transmission Line will consist of approximately 18 miles of 161 kV transmission line located in portions of Midway, Mountain Lake, Odin, and Cedar townships in Cottonwood, Martin, and Watonwan Counties, Minnesota. The Transmission Line will connect the Big Bend Wind Project and the Red Rock Solar Project to an existing 345 kV transmission line near Xcel Energy Crandall Switching Station in Martin County, Minnesota.

The attached map outlines the location of the Wind Farm, the Solar Project, and the Transmission Line.

# PROPERTY ACQUISITION

Big Bend and Red Rock have, through voluntary agreements, secured most of the private real estate rights necessary to construct the Wind Project and the Solar Project. If additional property rights are required for the Transmission Line, Big Bend will seek to negotiate voluntary easement agreements with each affected landowner. If Big Bend and the landowner are unable to negotiate an easement for the right-of-way, Big Bend reserves the right to evaluate whether the use of eminent domain is appropriate under Minn. Stat. Ch. 117, based on specific circumstances.

#### **CERTIFICATES OF NEED**

Minnesota Statutes Section 216B.243, subdivision 2, states that "no large energy facility" shall be sited or constructed in Minnesota without the issuance of a CN. Because the Wind Project and the Solar Project are both larger than 50 MW, they meet the definition of a large energy facility and will each require a CN prior to the issuance of their site permits and construction. Big Bend and Red Rock filed their CN applications with the Commission on November 9, 2020.

The Commission will consider the CN applications pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 216B.243 and implementing rules, Minn. R. Ch. 7849. The statutes and rules also establish notice requirements for various stages of the process. Per statute, the Commission shall approve or deny the CN within twelve (12) months of the CN Application.

The Commission will hold a public meeting on the CN applications. The Commission will provide notice of this meeting to persons whose names are on the Project contact list, those listed on a general service list, local government officials in the area of the proposed Project, and those

persons who own property adjacent to any site or within any route affected by the proposed Project. At this meeting, the public will be afforded an opportunity to ask questions and present comments and suggest alternative and possible impacts to be evaluated in the environmental report.

#### ROUTE PERMIT AND SITE PERMIT PROCESS

Apex has requested that the Commission jointly process the CN applications with the Solar Project Site Permit application, the Wind Project Site Permit application, and the Transmission Line route permit.

The Commission will consider the Wind Project SP Application pursuant to Minn. Stat. Ch. 216F and Minn. R. Ch. 7854. The Commission will consider the Solar Project SP Application pursuant to the alternative permitting process outlined in Minn. Stat. § 216E.04 and Minn. R. 7840.2800 through 7850.3900.

A Route Permit from the Commission is required before the Transmission Line can be constructed. The Power Plant Siting Act (Minn. Stat. Ch. 216E) and implementing rules in Minn. R. parts 7850.1000 to 7850.5600 establish the requirements for submitting and processing a Route Permit Application. The statutes and rules also establish notice requirements for various stages of the process.

The Commission will consider the Route Permit Application under the Alternative Process outlined in Minn. Stat. § 216E.04, subd. 2(3) and Minn. R. 7850.2800, subp. 1(C), because the Project is an HVTL between 100 and 200 kV. The Commission has up to six months from the time the application is accepted as complete to process and make a decision on the Route Permit according to Minnesota Statutes, Section 216E.04, subd. 7 and Minnesota Rule 7850.3900, subp. 1, but that time period is extended up to 12 months from the time the application is accepted as complete because the Project also requires a CN before it can receive a Route Permit and the process for a CN is up to 12 months.

Within sixty (60) days after the Commission accepts the Route Permit Application as complete, the Commission will schedule a public meeting to provide information to the public about the Project and to afford the public an opportunity to present comments and ask questions. At this meeting, members of the public may comment on the scope of the draft Environmental Assessment ("EA") that the Department of Commerce, Energy, Environmental Review and Analysis unit ("EERA") will prepare. Once the public meeting is scheduled, notice of the meeting will be provided to persons whose names are on the Project contact list and will be published in a legal newspaper of general circulation in the Project Area.

Once EERA completes the draft EA, EERA will make the document available for public review by placing a copy of the document in a public library or other governmental office in each county where the Project is proposed, and will hold an informational meeting to provide for the opportunity to comment on the draft EA. A period for written comments will also be provided.

After the draft EA has been completed, a public hearing (conducted by an administrative law judge from the Office of Administrative Hearings) will be held. Any person may speak at the public

hearing, present documentary evidence, ask questions of Apex representatives and EERA staff, and submit comments.

Further details regarding upcoming meetings and comment periods on all five applications will be provided by Apex and the Commission in the future.







You must apply on or before December 15, 2020.

Once homestead is granted, annual applications are not necessary unless they are requested by the county assessor.

Contact the assessor by December 15, 2020 if the use of the property you own or occupy as a qualifying relative has changed during the past year.

If you sell, move, or for any reason no longer qualify for the homestead classification, you are required to notify the county assessor within 30 days of the
