Minnesota Power provides the following brief update in the above-referenced Docket. ALLETE's annual Form 10-K filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission on February 17, 2021 provided the following update on Verso's notice of termination of its electric service agreement for the Duluth Mill:

<u>Verso Corporation</u>. In June 2020, Verso Corporation indefinitely idled its paper mill in Duluth, Minnesota (Duluth Mill). Verso Corporation stated the decision was due to the accelerated decline in graphic paper demand resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic and has disclosed it is considering options for the Duluth Mill, including marketing for a sale. On January 29, 2021, Verso Corporation provided notice of termination for its contract effective in January 2025, with no demand charge expected after February 2023 (minimal demand charge through January 2023).
