WSB, on behalf of Petroleum Fuels Company (PFC), hereby submits PFC's Application for a Gas Pipeline Routing Permit for the Pine Bend Pipeline Project ("Project") in Dakota County, Minnesota. The Project will include a four-inch steel pipeline approximately 5600 feet in length in Inver Grove Heights, MN. This pipeline will have a wall thickness of 0.237 inches, a maximum allowable operating pressure of 1440 psig, and an operating pressure of 670 psig. The area along the proposed pipeline route qualifies as a Class 2 area under the definitions in 49 C.F.R. Part 192.5.

The Project will transport gas from a Renewable Natural Gas Processing Facility to be constructed to process the landfill gas extracted from the Republic Services Pine Bend Landfill to a delivery point into the Northern States Power Company (Minnesota) d/b/a Xcel Energy (NSPM) high-pressure gas system. The gas will meet the specification required for renewable natural gas as established by NSP.

The Application is being made under the Partial Exemption Permitting processes set forth in Minnesota Rules 7852.0600 to 7852.0700. Hard copies of the Application will be provided to Minnesota Department of Commerce and Commission Staff. A Certificate of Service is also included.
