I have not and will not sign a waiver for wind access buffer setback for my land. Does the PUC intend to grant waiver for wind turbines without landowners consent?

I have two concerns if PUC grants waivers arbitrarily: 1) I will not be able to have a home on my property (SW 1/4 Section 5 of DeWald township) which will be without excess noise and shadows from windturbines. 2) There has been a noticeable decrease of bird population, especially waterfowl in Section 5 wetland areas since turbines located surrounding Section 5.

Windturbines which will be noncompliant with present regulations should be decommissioned and moved to achieve compliance.

Landowners should not be made to suffer because of poor planning. Longer turbine blades were available when this project was constructed.
