Dear Mr. Seuffert:

I represent the City of Wadena, a Minnesota municipal utility (the "City"), which is authorized, on behalf of the City and Todd-Wadena Electric Cooperative, a rural electric cooperative utility (the "Cooperative") (collectively, the "Parties") to make this joint filing.

#### Summary of the Joint Request

This filing constitutes the Parties' joint request that the MPUC update the official service territory map to reflect an agreed-upon change in the Parties' electric service territory boundaries. This joint request concerns the permanent transfer of an area located within the city limits of the City of Wadena and within the electric service territory assigned to the Cooperative (identified as the "Affected Area"), as further described below.

#### Legal Authorities

Under Minnesota Statutes, Section 216B.44(a), a municipal utility expands its assigned electric service territory, upon reaching agreement with the neighboring utility as to compensation: "Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 216B.38 to 216B.42, whenever a municipality which owns and operates an electric utility (1) extends its

corporate boundaries through annexation or consolidation, or (2) determines to extend its service territory within its existing corporate boundaries, the municipality shall thereafter furnish electric service to these areas unless the area is already receiving electric service from an electric utility, in which event, the municipality may purchase the facilities of the electric utility serving the area." Minn. Stat. § 216B.44(a). In addition, "no electric utility shall render or extend electric service at retail within the assigned service area of another electric utility unless the electric utility consents thereto in writing . . . " Minn. Stat. § 216B.40 (2018).

In the present case, the transfer occurred pursuant to Section 216B.44: the Affected Area lies within the city limits; the Parties have agreed upon appropriate compensation; and the parties have agreed to the City providing service. Currently, the only customer in the Affected Area is one commercial customer receiving temporary/construction service.

Minnesota Statutes, Section 216B.39, subd. 3 addresses changes to the assigned service territory map after 1975: "the commission may on its own or at the request of an electric utility make changes in the boundaries of the assigned service areas, but only after notice and hearing .... " By its terms, Section 216B.44(a) excludes Section 216B.39. Minn. Stat. 216B.44(a) ("notwithstanding the provisions of § sections 216B.38 to 216B.42,"). Nonetheless, the Parties acknowledge the public policy in having an accurate and updated official service territory boundary map. Accordingly. the Parties request that the Commission update its official records as to electric service territory boundaries to reflect the Parties' permanent change in the Affected Area.

#### Underlying Information

Attached as <u>Exhibit A</u> is a set of maps that depict the boundaries of the Affected Area (outlined in orange). The Affected Area involves approximately 42 acres and temporary/construction service for one commercial customer.

Attached as Exhibit B is a legal description of the Affected Area.

### Customer Notice

To avoid unnecessary duplication of facilities and to ensure a smooth construction process, the Parties have agreed to the City providing service to the Affected Area. The Parties acknowledge that the Commission wishes to direct separate notice to any customers as to the pending proceeding before the Commission. Attached as <u>Exhibit C</u> is a proposed notice letter to be sent to all customers in the Affected Area.



#### Legal Description of Affected Area

All of the Northeast Quarter (NE1/4) of Section One (1), Township One Hundred Thirty Four (134), Range Thirty-six (36) lying North of the right-of-way of Trunk Highway 10, EXCEPT that part thereof West of the following described line: Commencing at the cast iron monument which designates the Northwest corner of Section One (1), Township One Hundred Thirty-four (134), Range Thirty-six (36); thence South 89° 52' 14" East, 3672.68 feet on an assumed bearing along the North line of said Section One (1) to the point of beginning of the boundary line to herein described; thence South 00° 12' 39" East, 29.44 feet to an iron monument; thence continuing South 00° 12' 39" East, 1478.98 feet to an iron monument; thence continuing South 00° 12' 39" East 165 feet more or less to the northeasterly right of way line of Trunk Highway 10 and thence terminating, EXCEPT the East 660 feet thereof.


