I. BACKGROUND

Minnesota Power (MP) is a Minnesota corporation and a public utility under Minn. Stat. Section 216B.02, subd. East Central Energy (ECE) is an electric cooperative formed pursuant to the provisions of Minn. Stat. Chapter 308A. The parties, MP and ECE have a mutual agreement to modify the border between their exclusive service territories.

II. SUMMARY OF PROPOSAL

On July 20, 2020, Minnesota Power filed 45 service-area-related agreements with various other utilities, one of which was between MP and ECE (see Attachment 17 to the Docket No. E015/SA-20-609 filing). On September 22, 2020, Minnesota Power filed a request (Petition) on behalf of itself and East Central Power that the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) approve their Service Territory Exception Agreement.

After review by the Department, it became obvious from Attachment 17 to the July 20, 2020 filing in Docket No. E015/SA-20-609, that the real intent of the Parties was to request approval of two permanent service territory modifications where the utilities had overlapping service areas. Attachment 17 is a Service Territory Agreement (Agreement) entered into by MP and ECE dated February 27, 2015, that had never before been submitted to the Commission for approval, even though item 7 to the Agreement stated that "MP will file a Joint Petition with the Commission along with the Agreement requesting approval under Minn. Stat. 216B.39, subd. 3 for a modification of assigned service territories."

On October 15, 2020, MP confirmed that the intent of the Attachment 17 Agreement is for two permanent transfers of service territory and is not a service by exception agreement.

According to the Agreement, service territory boundaries for Township 41 North, Range 20 West of Section 29 and E ½ of Section 30, Pine County, MN are shown on Exhibit A of the Agreement. Exhibit A is a map that shows the electric service territory boundary in the above sections for ECE and MP. Polygon A is in ECE territory and Polygon B is in MP service Territory.

According to the Agreement, the Parties agree that ZHINGWAAK OODENA SECOND ADDITION and ZHINGWAAK OODENA THIRD ADDITION are located in both ECE and MP service territories as shown on Exhibit B.

III. DEPARTMENT ANALYSIS

A. ASSIGNED SERVICE AREA

Minnesota Statutes section 216B.39, subd. (3) states:

... the commission may on its own or at the request of an electric utility make changes in the boundaries of the assigned service areas, but only after notice and hearing as provided for in sections 216B.17 and 216B.1.

Transfer to ECE from MP

ECE will permanently service all lots in the ZHINGWAAK OODENA SECOND ADDITION and lot 14 in the ZHINGWAAK OODENA THIRD ADDITION of Township 41 North, Range 20 West of Section 29 and E ½ of Section 30, Pine County, MN.

Transfer to MP from ECE

MP will permanently service all lots in the ZHINGWAAK OODENA THIRD ADDITION of Township 41 North, Range 20 West of Section 29 and E ½ of Section 30, Pine County, MN, except for lot 14 which will be serviced by ECE.

B. CUSTOMER NOTICE

There was no customer notice since the parties noted no customers will experience a change in service provider as a result of this Agreement.

C. COMPENSATION

According to the Agreement, the parties agreed that no compensation is due to either Party for the exchange of service areas.

Thus, the Department agrees that the Parties' request is reasonable.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

The Department recommends that the Commission approve the requested service territory transfers. MnGeo should update the Commission's maps for Pine County to reflect the service area designations as shown on the maps in the Agreement.
