NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING AND COMMENT PERIOD

Issued: July 2, 2021

In the Matter of the Application of Xcel Energy for an Amendment to the Site Permit for the Grand Meadow Wind Farm Repower Project in Mower County.

PUC Docket Number: IP6646/WS-07-839

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) will hold public meetings and provide a written comment period on the site permit amendment application of Xcel Energy (Xcel) for their proposed modifications to the Grand Meadow Wind Farm in Mower County. Xcel filed a Site Permit Amendment Application with the Commission on May 27, 2021 requesting to repower the project's 67 turbines and increase the energy production of the facility, improve overall reliability, and extend the service life of the turbines. Xcel proposes to retrofit the existing wind farm by installing new, larger rotors and replacing components within the wind turbine nacelles. Upon repowering, the energy capacity of each turbine would increase from 1.5 MW to 1.6 MW resulting in a total increase of the project's total nameplate capacity from 100.5 MW to approximately 107.2 MW. The turbine replacements would increase the turbine diameter from 253 feet to 318 feet on 52 of the turbines, and to 299 feet on the remaining 15 turbines.

The purpose of this meeting is to provide information about the proposed project, discuss the state's review process, and to accept verbal or written comments. Representatives from the Commission, the Department of Commerce staff and Xcel will be available at the meeting to answer questions.


