Dear Mr. Seuffert:

The Office of the Attorney General – Residential Utilities Division ("OAG") respectfully submits this letter in response to the Commission's June 7, 2021 Notice of Comment Period on the petition of Minnesota Power (or "Company") for approval of deferred-accounting treatment of its electric vehicle ("EV") program costs.¹

Deferred accounting is an extraordinary ratemaking remedy that the Commission generally reserves for costs that are "unforeseen, unusual, and large enough to have a significant impact on the utility's financial condition."² The Commission has, however, created a limited exception for EV pilot programs (1) that advance the important legislative policy goal of engaging utilities in transportation electrification, (2) that are modest in size and duration, and (3) for which the deferral is limited to costs incurred between the date of the order approving deferred-accounting treatment and the beginning of the test year of the utility's next rate case.³

If the Commission grants Minnesota Power's petition, the OAG recommends that it apply the same conditions it imposed on prior utilities' requests for deferred accounting of EV program costs. Specifically, if the Commission grants the petition, it should limit the deferral period so that the Company is allowed to track costs incurred between the date of the Commission's order and the test year of the Company's next rate case. This requirement is consistent with the

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Commission's past decisions and would appropriately balance the goal of encouraging transportation electrification with the need to protect ratepayers from single-issue ratemaking that could result in overrecovery of the utility's revenue requirement.
