- 2. Direct CenterPoint Energy and any interested entity or regulated utility to file proposed lifecycle greenhouse gas accounting frameworks and cost-benefit analysis frameworks for the NGIA in this docket by the first comment deadline, which will be no later than January 30, 2022.
- 3. Delegate authority to the Executive Secretary to establish comment periods for this docket, including the ability to modify timelines as needed.
- 4. Direct the Executive Secretary to explore options for procuring a neutral expert advisor, if practicable, to assist the Commission in reviewing and evaluating proposals and comments in this docket.
- 5. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 216B.62, subd. 8, authorize the Commissioner of the Department of Commerce to ask the Commissioner of Management and Budget for permission to incur costs for specialized technical professional investigative services to assist with matters related to this docket and Dockets No. G-999/CI-21-565, In the Matter of a Commission Evaluation of Changes to Natural Gas Utility Regulatory and Policy Structures to Meet State Greenhouse Gas Reduction Goals.
