In the Matter of Establishing an Updated 2016 Estimate of the Costs of Future Carbon Dioxide Regulation on Electricity Generation under Minn. Stat. §216H.06.

What values should the Commission adopt as the likely range of costs for future CO2 regulation on electricity generation? In what year should the values begin to be applied? Should the Commission establish values for IRPs filed in 2016 and 2017? Should the Commission open a generic docket to reexamine the relationship between the external cost of CO2 and the anticipated regulatory cost of CO₂? (PUC: **Twite**)
